[4] The Level Two Rate is available to each shipper that, during the open season held by Belle Fourche Pipeline Company in December 2010, signed a Throughput and Deficiency Agreement for the transportation of at least 1,825,000 barrels per year over a five-year period.

[5] The Level Three Rate is available to each shipper that, during the open season held by Belle Fourche Pipeline Company in December 2010, signed a Throughput and Deficiency Agreement for the transportation of at least 3,650,000 barrels per year over a five-year period.

[6] [N] Additional charges are applicable for movements beyond Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB, Platte County, Wyoming to connecting carriers, as set forth in Belle Fourche’s F.E.R.C. No. 129.0.0 and subsequent reissues thereof. [C] Guernsey Station refers to Belle Fourche Pipeline Company’s Guernsey Station in Guernsey, Wyoming (“Belle Fourche Guernsey Station”). The rates set forth herein to the Belle Fourche Guernsey Station do not include rates for transportation to Platte Pipe Line Company’s Guernsey Station in Guernsey Wyoming (“Platte Guernsey Station”). Rates and routing for transportation service from the Belle Fourche Guernsey Station to the Platte Guernsey Station are set forth in Belle Fourche Pipeline Company’s F.E.R.C. No. 115.12.0 and reissues thereof and are in addition to the rates set forth herein to the Belle Fourche Guernsey Station.

EXCEPTIONS AND ADDITIONS TO BELLE FOURCHE PIPELINE COMPANY’S FERC No. [W] 112.17.0 ~~112.13.0~~:

Item 15, Quality Specifications: In addition to complying with the quality specifications set forth in Item No. 15 (Specifications as to Quality Received) in Belle Fourche Pipeline LLC’s F.E.R.C. No. [W] 112.17.0 ~~112.13.0~~ and subsequent reissues thereof, all petroleum movements received at Baker Station must have (1) an API gravity of thirty-six (36) degrees or greater, and (2) less than 0.20% sulfur by weight.
