APPLICATION OF RATE: The rate named herein applies only on shipments of commodity named herein, from points named herein, to destinations named herein, for interstate transportation beyond.

~~[C] *As a temporary accommodation to Shippers, effective May 26, 2020 and continuing to June 30, 2020 (“Qualifying Period”), any Shipper that qualified for or would have qualified for, as applicable, a volume incentive rate(s) set forth herein for the months of March and April 2019 based on such Shipper’s monthly average of volumes transported on Carrier’s system during such months, will continue to qualify for such volume incentive rate(s) during the Qualifying Period, even if such Shipper does not meet the requisite volume threshold applicable to such volume incentive rate(s) during such period. This provision is being offered as a temporary accommodation to Shippers and will automatically expire on June 30, 2020. If a Shipper does meet the applicable volume threshold commencing July 1, 2020 and thereafter, such Shipper shall not qualify for the volume incentive rate(s) set forth herein.~~

[1] Additional charges are applicable for movements beyond Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB to connecting carriers, as set forth in Belle Fourche's F.E.R.C. No. 129.4.0 and subsequent reissues thereof. Rates set forth herein apply to crude oil delivered into Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB.

[2] Rates apply to sweet and sour crude oil delivered directly into Platte Pipeline (Guernsey). Minimum total nomination from all shippers is 40,000 barrels per month.

[3] Rates apply to sweet crude oil gathered in Converse and Campbell Cos., WY only.

[4] The 0.2% volume correction for evaporation and loss during transportation, as provided in Item No. 30 in the rules tariff, does not apply to intra-Guernsey movements where such barrels already had the volume correction on Carrier and no additional tanking is required.

[5] Rate applies to the interstate movement of crude oil originating at Guernsey Station and delivered into Rocky Mountain Pipeline at Ft. Laramie Station.

[6] The acreage dedication rates shall be assessed for movements from Campbell and Converse Counties, WY to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB by any shipper that has entered into and has an effective dedication agreement with Belle Fourche Pipeline Company, pursuant to which such shipper has dedicated for shipment on Carrier's System all of the Crude Petroleum produced from a specified drilling spacing unit (or DSU) located within Campbell or Converse County, WY.

[7] The Tier 1 volume incentive rates shall be assessed for movements of light sweet Petroleum from Campbell and Converse Counties, WY to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB by any Shipper that ships in a given month an average of at least 5,000 barrels per day ("Tier 1 Volume Threshold") of gathered volumes from Campbell and Converse Counties, WY to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB. For clarity, only a Shipper's barrels of light sweet Petroleum that are gathered by Belle Fourche in Campbell and Converse Counties, WY and transported to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB shall count towards the Tier 1 Volume Threshold; any volumes credited to Shipper via a line transfer or that are received from Shipper via trucks shall not count towards the Tier 1 Volume Threshold. To the extent a Shipper meets the Tier 1 Volume Threshold in a month and thereby qualifies for the Tier 1 volume incentive rates pursuant to this Note 7, such Shipper shall also qualify for a mainline volume incentive rate of **[I] 76.51** cents per barrel for any volumes that are received from Shipper via truck and transported to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB during such month.

[8] The Tier 2 volume incentive rates shall be assessed for movements of light sweet Petroleum from Campbell and Converse Counties, WY to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB by any Shipper that ships in a given month an average of at least 2,500 barrels per day ("Tier 2 Volume Threshold") of gathered volumes from Campbell and Converse Counties, WY to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB. For clarity, only a Shipper's barrels of light sweet Petroleum that are gathered by Belle Fourche in Campbell and Converse Counties, WY and transported to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB shall count towards the Tier 2 Volume Threshold; any volumes credited to Shipper via a line transfer or that are received from Shipper via trucks shall not count towards the Tier 2 Volume Threshold. To the extent a Shipper meets the Tier 2 Volume Threshold in a month and thereby qualifies for the Tier 2 volume incentive rates pursuant to this Note 8, such Shipper shall also qualify for a mainline volume incentive rate of **[I] 86.71** cents per barrel for any volumes that are received from Shipper via truck and transported to the Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB during such month.

[9] Carrier shall levy a Diluent Charge against sour barrels delivered to Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB except for those barrels originating at Belle Fourche Guernsey HUB ("Total Sour Barrels"). The Diluent Charge to each Shipper shall be calculated as follows:

Diluent Charge to Shipper (\$ per barrel) = Net Cost of Diluent to Carrier per Month ÷ Total Sour Barrels transported by Carrier per Month.

Net Cost of Diluent to Carrier per Month = (Total barrels of Diluent delivered to Carrier's Diluent Receipt Points Per Month multiplied by the Average Monthly Price of Rocky Mountain Sweet Crude at Casper,

Wyoming) minus (Total barrels of Diluent sold on behalf of Carrier at Guernsey, Wyoming per Month multiplied by the Average Monthly Price of Wyoming General Sour Crude at Guernsey, Wyoming).

Carrier will provide with each Shipper's monthly invoice a copy of the Diluent Charge calculation, including the Average Monthly Price of Rocky Mountain Sweet Crude at Casper and the Average Monthly Price of Wyoming General Sour Crude at Guernsey. Gravity adjustments will be made per Item No. 68 of Carrier's F.E.R.C. No. 112.20.0 and subsequent reissues thereof.

Sample Calculation:

Net Cost of Diluent to Carrier Per Month = (18,000 barrels of Diluent x \$50.00 per barrel¹) - (18,000 barrels of Diluent x \$40.00 per barrel²) = \$180,000.

Diluent Charge to Shipper (\$ per barrel) = \$180,000 ÷ 500,000 barrels = \$0.36 per barrel.
